

Versailles / St-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse

Veloscenic : Paris to Mont-Saint-Michel cycle route

Départ Versailles Arrivée St-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse

Durée 1 h 37 min Distance 23,95 Km

Niveau I cycle often Thématique Alternative route by Versailles After the magnificence of the Château de Versailles, cycle on into the Parc Naturel Régional de la Haute Vallée de Chevreuse, which has its own rich natural, cultural and historical heritage to explore. Riding along a mix of cycle paths and quiet roads, cross the Plateau de Saclay to reach St-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse.

Stage description and details:

On this stage, you mainly stick to cycle paths, with the odd stretch on really quiet roads shared with motorized traffic.

On the border between the parishes of Magny-les-Hameaux and Saint Rémy-lès-Chevreuse, the Chemin de la Butte aux Buis has been altered to make it easier for cyclists to tackle, but this hill still presents a steep challenge. We recommend that you dismount here.

Don't miss:

 The Château de Versailles, a massive masterpiece of the French arts, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit the unmissable apartments designed for the French king and queen, the Hall of Mirrors, and the sumptuous gardens dreamt up by Le Nôtre. The Maison-musée Raymond Devos in Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse, a house in which the much-loved comedian lived for over 40 years; you'll learn a lot about this zany French cultural figure on a visit here.

Food and drink en route:

• Versailles: boasting many food and drinks shops. Among the town's many markets is the one that takes place daily except Mondays within and outside the Halles Notre Dame, a covered food hall.

Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse: not only for the numerous food and drinks shops in town, but also its markets on Wednesday and Saturday mornings, plus the covered market on Rue Ditte.

Bring up **Accueil Velo accredited restaurants** by clicking on the clicking on the sicon on the map. De-select "only show accueil velo accredited services" to view further possibilities.

Repair Service:

Consult **the list of all the bike repairers** along or near the route.
